Below are some guidelines to help you prepare your oral presentation.

- 1. Each presentation has the different allotted time. Please check the congress program for your assigned time.
- 2. All presentations should be made on a computer, using Microsoft PowerPoint.
- 3. A presentation developed in PowerPoint 2007 and later versions of PowerPoint should not be a problem.
- 4. You can bring your data by USB or CD; no ZIP or Floppy discs are accepted.
- If you are MAC user, please bring your own laptop along with AC adaptor and connector to mini D-sub (15pins).
- Those whose presentations include movies please make sure to bring your own laptop. Please be informed that your laptop needs to be equipped with mini D-sub (15 pins). Also make sure to bring your own AC adaptor.
- 7. Please bring your data/laptop at least 30 minutes prior to your presentation to the PC Preview desk which locates in the front of the each hall.
